

IAAPA VOLUNTEER SPEAKER AGREEMENT

The International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions (“the Association”) conducts programs and events at which presentations are delivered to attendees. To support these activities, the Association requires all presenters to provide a release and license for their participation.

This Volunteer Speaker Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by the individual identified in the signature block below (“the Speaker”) for all content presented during _____ (“the Event”), together with any related comments, handouts, illustrations, references, or other accompanying materials (collectively, “the Presentation”).

The Speaker agrees to comply with all rules, regulations, policies, and procedures of the Association in connection with the preparation and delivery of the Presentation, including, without limitation, required deadlines for submissions and any required disclosure of commercial interests or conflicts of interest.

The Speaker grants the Association the right to record and broadcast the Presentation using audio, video, and/or other electronic recording methods. The Speaker further grants the Association a non-exclusive, irrevocable, worldwide license to reproduce, distribute, publish, and/or sell the recorded Presentation, or any part thereof, in print or electronic form, including, but not limited to, through IAAPA’s mobile application and learning management system (LMS) after the scheduled live presentation has concluded.

The Speaker retains all copyright to the Presentation.

The Speaker also authorizes the Association to use the Speaker’s name, likeness, photograph, and biographical information in connection with the use, distribution, and promotion of the Presentation and related materials.

The Speaker warrants and represents that the Presentation does not violate any proprietary or personal rights of others (including, without limitation, any copyrights or privacy rights); that the Presentation is factually accurate and contain no matter libelous or otherwise unlawful content; that the Speaker has obtained all necessary permissions from any persons or organizations whose materials are included in the Presentation; that the Speaker has full power to grant this license; and that there are no rights outstanding that would diminish, encumber, or impair the full enjoyment or exercise of this license granted to the Association.

It is understood that the Speaker will not receive any royalty or other monetary compensation from the Association for the license and subsequent use by the Association. This license does not prohibit the Speaker from using the Presentation or related materials in the future, except that the Speaker may not use the Association’s name, logos, or trademarks in connection with any such use without the Association’s prior written approval.

The Speaker agrees that this Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, U.S.A., without regard to its conflict of law principles. The Speaker further consents to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state or federal courts located in Orange County, Florida for any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement.
